List of Kremlin propagandists involved in military aggression against Ukraine

The war unleashed by Vladimir Putin against Ukraine is already in its second year. Every day of this war more and more Ukrainians, both soldiers and civilians, including women and children, get killed. Millions of people have fled their homes, becoming refugees or internally displaced persons. Ukraine is experiencing a severe demographic crisis. The war is also destroying the country's infrastructure and causing enormous damage to the Ukrainian economy. And so far, none of those who initiated this war, directed it and promoted it have been held fully responsible.

The only form of responsibility to which certain Russian citizens have been subjected has been international sanctions. During the war, a large number of Russians, among them public officials, legislators and other Russian decision makers involved in promoting the war, have been placed on sanctions lists of various countries. However, there is a considerable number of people who play no less sinister a role than politicians, officials and the military. These are those who, using their influence, their public visibility and their audience, poison the Russian society with hatred towards Ukraine and Ukrainians, glorify the war, provide information support for it, promote pro-war narratives, and sometimes pursue practical outcomes, such as raising funds to arm and equip the Russian mercenaries fighting in Ukraine.

By compiling this list, we, the team of the Putin's List project, would like to extend the register of those who can be called Promoters of war. This list includes some journalists, so-called "experts" invited to the Russian federal channels and other media outlets to justify and promote the war, as well as some "public figures" and "opinion leaders" who use their position to promote Kremlin war propaganda. In addition, we have paid considerable attention to those who are usually bypassed by the sanctions policies of the Free World countries. We are talking about the owners, editors and authors of so-called "turbo-patriotic" Telegram channels which promote through social media the so-called Z-ideology consisting of ideas, beliefs and perceptions justifying this war. Some of the propagandists use their Telegram channels and other social media for purely utilitarian militaristic purposes, such as recruiting mercenaries or raising funds to equip and arm them.

This list is the result of the work of the Putin's List team, a project of the Free Russia Forum, which aims to collect and systematize data regarding individuals implicated in the building and development of Vladimir Putin's dictatorial system which uses suppression of civil liberties in Russia, aggressive foreign policy threatening international security, corruption and antihuman propaganda.

Putin's List is meant to be used in a variety of ways. First, our aim is to convince the Free World governments to include the listed individuals into their sanctions lists. Second, the List serves as a record of the crimes of Putin's regime to help future criminal justice or lustration procedures. Note: Putin's List was first submitted to the United States Congress in 2019.

As Putin's war in Ukraine rages on, the work on Putin's List becomes even more important with the growing need to systematize data on those who are responsible for this war, including state propagandists.

After Ukraine's victory, many of those on the list will want to evade justice. They will try to renounce Putin's war crimes, leave Russia and settle happily in the West. This list is aimed, among other things, at preventing them from doing so. Those who promote this war, the propagandists justifying the military aggression and the war crimes should have no place in a democratic society. They should be considered perpetrators not deserving the benefits of democratic governance and the rule of law.

Some of these people are still enjoying the West, travel there, spend the blood-stained money there showing off their Western life style through the social media and boasting their impunity to the Western sanctions.

We propose to ban those listed from travel to Western countries by denying them visas. The lawful and fair measure we propose will make many Putin supporters among the Russian elite think about their future and reconsider their attitude to the war.

Candidate of Political Sciences (1992). Professor of the Institute of Media, Faculty of Creative Industries, National Research University Higher School of Economics. Lieutenant of reserve.

Fatigarov Vasilii (Фатигаров Василий Юрьевич), 20.10.1968. War correspondent, captain 1st rank. Graduated from the Higher Naval Engineering School specializing in shipbuilding. From 1991 to 2009, he was a war correspondent. In 2019, he was reinstated to military service in the Main Military and Political Directorate of the Russian Armed Forces, retired in 2021 for health reasons. Participates in political propaganda talk shows, where he sometimes presents himself as a political analyst. Supports and justifies Russia's war against Ukraine and occupation of Ukrainian territories.

In 2014-15 actively supported (also being armed himself) the pro-Russian formations in Donbass. Publicly endorses the full-scale war against Ukraine. Known under as Kisa, Combat 18, Kombat, Kompot.

Kavinov Roman (Кавинов Роман Валерьевич), 10.06.1975. Deputy Chairman of the Legislative Assembly of Vladimir region, member of committees of the Legislative Assembly of Vladimir region. Known for scandalous statements in support of repressions and the war against Ukraine.

Kazakov Aleksandr (Казakov Александр Юрьевич), 06.12.1965. Political scientist, public figure. He was a member of the organizing committee of the United Congress of the Russian Community of Latvia, an activist of the Headquarters for the Protection of Russian Schools, as well as an advisor to the deceased head of so-called "DPR" Aleksandr Zakharchenko. Actively supports the aggressive war against Ukraine and the occupation of Ukrainian territories. On January 3, 2023, she publicly called on her husband, the commander of the 2nd Guards Combined Arms Army of the Russian Armed Forces, to avenge Russian servicemen killed in Makiivka.

Satanovskii Evgenii (Сатановский Евгений Янович), 15.06.1959. Russian propagandist, founder and president of

the research center "Middle East Institute" (formerly Institute for the Study of Israel and the Middle East). Candidate of economic sciences, professor. Member of the expert group for improving legislation on freedom of conscience and religious associations under the Expert Council of the State Duma Committee on the Development of Civil Society, Public and Religious Associations.

Sidorov Andrei (Сидоров Андрей Анатольевич), 02.11.1959. Dean of the Faculty of World Politics, Head of the Department of International Organizations and World Political Processes of the Faculty of World Politics of Moscow State University, Candidate of Historical Sciences, Associate Professor. Participant of the propaganda talk shows "Vremya Pokazhet" ("Время покажет"), "Right to Vote" ("Право голоса"), "Evening with Vladimir Solovev" ("Вечер с Владимиром Соловьевым"), "60 Minutes" ("60 минут").

Sivkov Konstantin (Сивков Константин Валентинович), 02.06.1954. Military expert, Doctor of Military Sciences, Deputy President of the Russian Academy of Rocket and Artillery Sciences, columnist of the "Tsargrad" ("Царьград") channel.

Shakhnazarov Karen (Шахназаров Карен Георгиевич), 08.07.1952. Soviet and Russian film director, screenwriter, film producer, public figure. He regularly takes part in the show "Evening with Vladimir Solovev", where he supports the war in Ukraine and denies Russia's war crimes in Ukraine. Also supports the annexation of Ukrainian territories.

Stepanenko Anton (Степаненко Антон Евгеньевич), 05.07.1965. Russian military journalist, TV presenter. Promotes the war of aggression against Ukraine, the occupation of Ukrainian territories, and the narrative of "neo-Nazism" in Ukraine. Contributes to the active dissemination of Kremlin's military propaganda.

Sych Artemii (Сыч Артемий). Co-host and co-administrator of the resource "Ordinary Tsarism"/"Listva" ("Обыкновенный царизм"/"Листва"), author of the imperialist blog "Spark" ("Искра").
